PUBLICATION AGREEMENT

This Publication Agreement (the “Agreement”), dated _____, is between _____ (the “Author”) and the *Michigan State Law Review* (the “Review”), and governs _____ (the “Article”).

1. The copyright in the Article shall remain with the Author. Nothing in this Agreement should be construed as an assignment of copyright ownership to the Review.
2. Any reproduction of the Article, including, but not limited to, its publication, posting, or excerption in print or on the Internet, shall give attribution to the Article’s original publication in the Review, using the following method of citation:

“Originally published in [year] MICH. ST. L. REV. [start page].”
3. The Author grants to the Review a license to print, publish, post, and distribute the Article in any and all mediums. This license includes, but is not limited to, the right to:
 - a. Authorize the electronic reproduction of the Article by LexisNexis and Westlaw;
 - b. Authorize others to reproduce the Article for noncommercial purposes;
 - c. Use only an abstract or portion of the Article in any authorized reproduction of the Article.
4. The Author warrants that:
 - a. The Author has the right to license the Article to the Review, and has not made any agreement that would conflict with this Agreement;
 - b. The Article has not previously been published, in whole or in part;
 - c. The Article does not infringe the copyright or property right of another;
 - d. The Article does not contain matter that is defamatory, violates another’s rights of privacy or publicity, or is otherwise unlawful;
 - e. The Author will indemnify and hold harmless the Michigan State University College of Law and the Review against any damages, losses, or expenses incurred as a result of the Author’s breach of any of the above warranties.
5. The Author authorizes the Review to edit and revise the Article prior to publication, and agrees to respond in reasonable time to edits, page proofs, and any related correspondence. Before the Article is published in the Review, the Article must be acceptable to both the Author and the Review.
